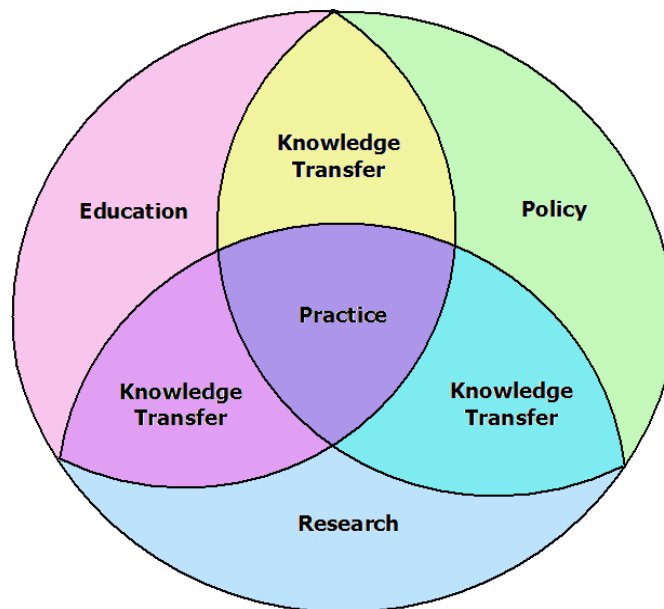

Community Needs Driven Research Network (CNDRN)

- First funded by Alberta Innovates Health Solutions
- Supported through an operational grant from Alberta Health until October 2018
- Purpose was to identify needs – **from the perspective of the community and care providers** - related to continuing care where education and/or research could help improve care

AND

- To encourage research and knowledge translation to address the identified issues.
