The Qualities of a Learning **Circle Facilitator**



A Learning Circle Facilitator...

- Must appear objective and neutral in his/her opinions.
- Develops a set of ground rules with the group and ensures they are followed.
- Guides the participants through the process to maintain focus.
- Summarizes important topics throughout the discussion.
- Creates an environment that allows everyone to participate in the conversation.
- Uses effective questioning skills, such as open-ended questions, to stimulate conversation.
- Acknowledges areas of agreement and opposition when coming to a decision.
- Actively listens to and values each member's point of view.
- Is enthusiastic!

Facilitator Neutrality

- As the facilitator, you should appear unbiased or neutral in your opinions.
- Encourage each group member to contribute to the discussion.
- Actively listen to and respect each individual's opinion.
- Be aware of your own verbal and non-verbal behaviours.
- Maintain your role as the facilitator.
